Please bring fluids to stay hydrated, lunch, shovels, pruning shears, weed-eaters, long sleeve shirts, long pants, gloves, and possibly a change of clothes. Please bring your flying/climbing equipment too if you want an afternoon flight or climb.

Our club (CCHPC) has a very successful partnership with the US Forest Service in the Adopt-a-Road program. We will be working under their guidelines. A ranger usually shows up for a while to observe and help. This is important in our efforts to maintain access to the area.

Please meet at the Tollhouse graveyard 8:30am. We need to fill-out some paperwork for the Forest Service and have a short safety meeting before heading up to work. It would be a great time-saver if volunteers could visit the CCHPC website and download the Adopt-a-Road emergency/medical form, fill it out, print a copy, and bring it to the workday. Our Club has received several awards and has been recognized for our past service.

The CCHPC would also like to recognize and thank our newest volunteers, the local rock climbers, who have expressed an interest to give back to this area. Thanks for all your support to maintain access to Tollhouse and help keep the Sierra National Forest the "Land of Many Uses".
